POSTING ON FACEBOOK

Log in at www.facebook.com through your usual account or access Facebook via mobile app on a smartphone or tablet. Add the hashtag #wi4h100 to any status updates or photo/video uploads you might share related to the Wisconsin 4-H Centennial. POSTING ON TWITTER

Log in at www.twitter.com through your usual account or access Twitter via mobile app on a smartphone or tablet. Add the hashtag #wi4h100 to any tweet you might share related to the Wisconsin 4-H Centennial.

POSTING ON INSTAGRAM
