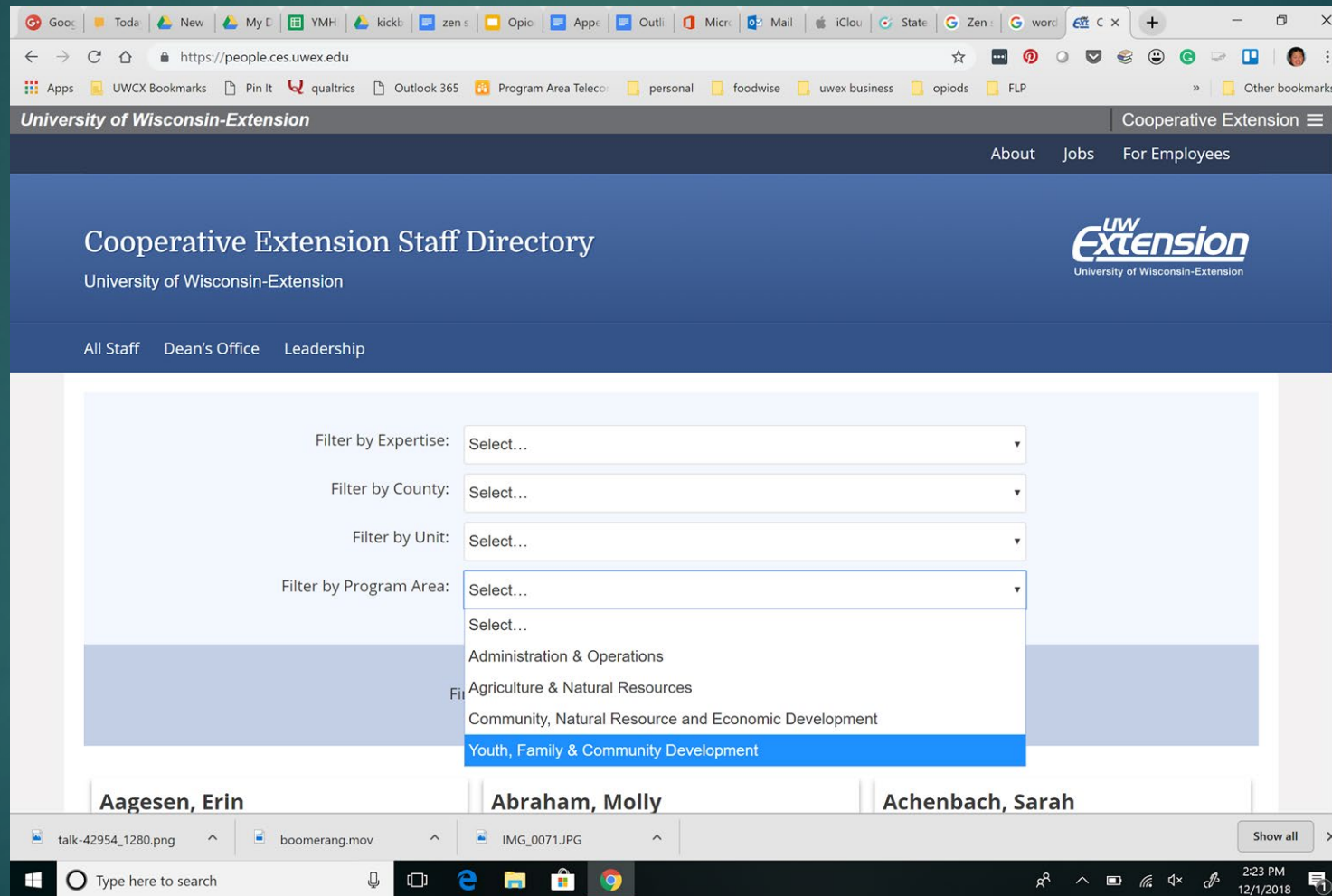

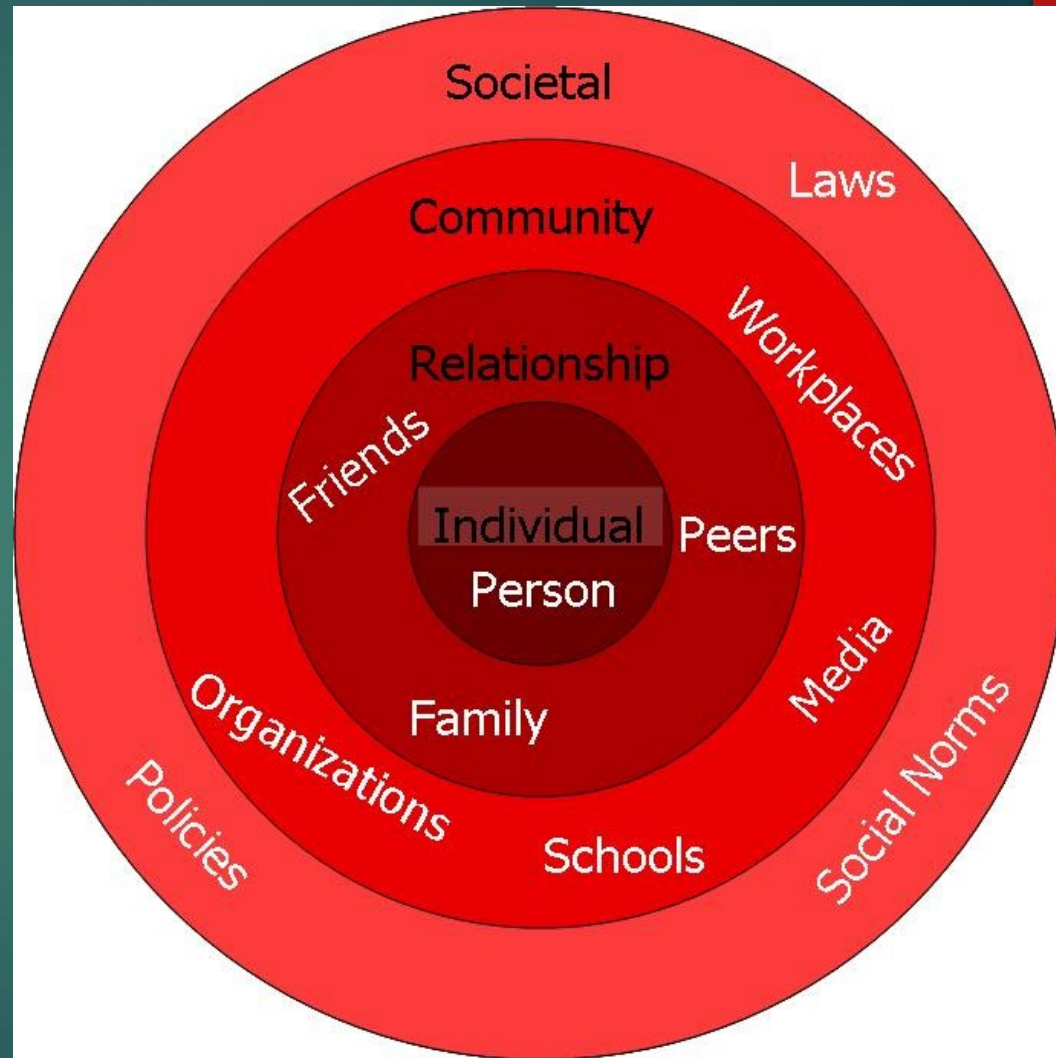

- We ALLEVIATE the effects of Substance Use Disorders.

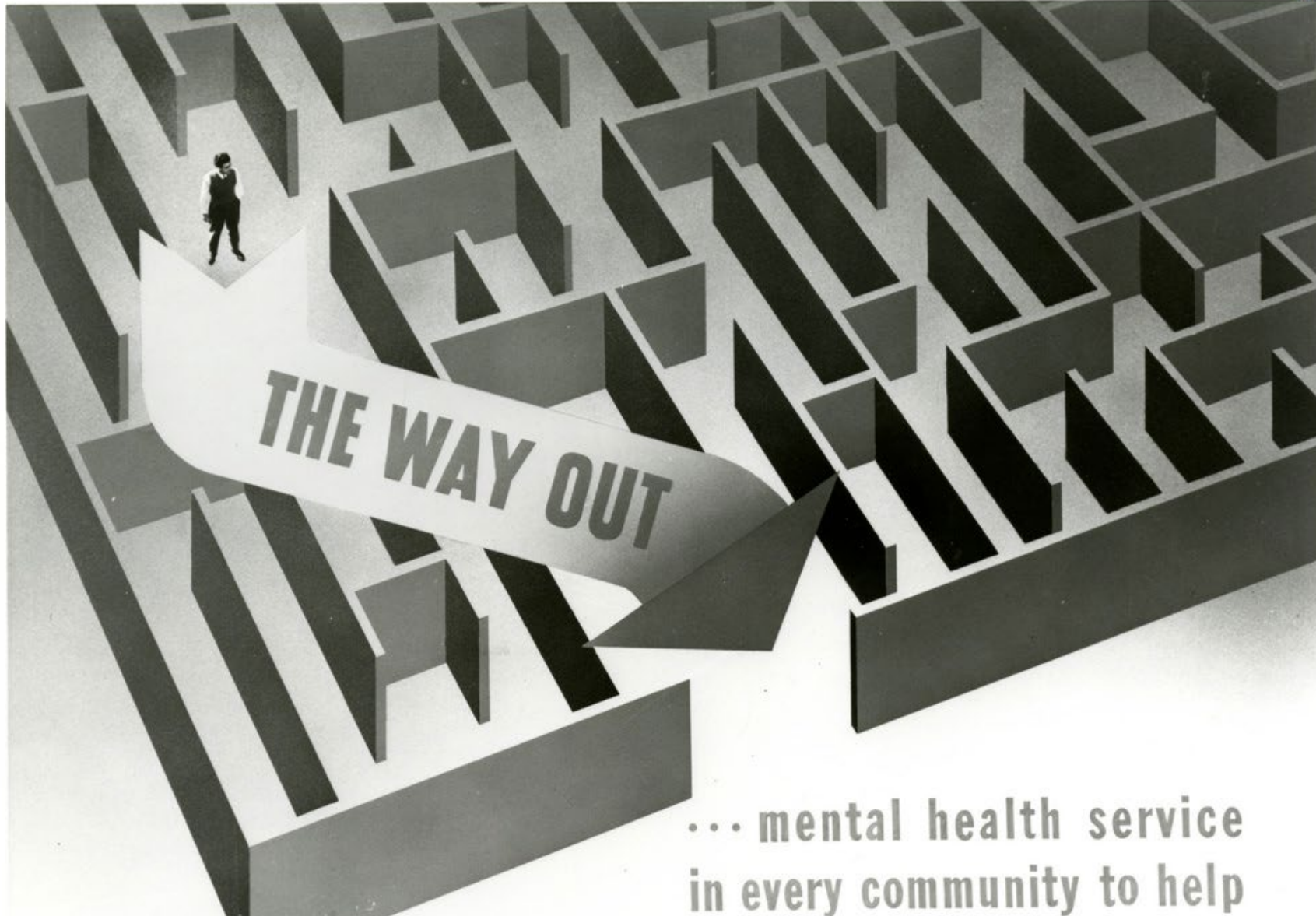
