<u>Recommendations on the future structure of Cooperative Extension are available for review and comment</u>. The recommendations in this document focus on Cooperative Extension's geographic structure, specifically the partnership with Wisconsin counties. We are requesting feedback on these recommendations from any staff, partners, and stakeholders.

Once it closes, results will be shared the the planning team, who will incorporate the feedback into their final recommendations to Chancellor Sandeen later this spring.
