Interpretation Equipment Rental Program

Looking for a better way to accommodate language needs?

The Office of Access, Inclusion, and Compliance provides the opportunity to rent simultaneous interpretation equipment for in-person programming and events.

Extension has two sets of one-way microphones, one handheld microphone, 24 receivers, and signage to use during programs, activities, and services that need simultaneous interpretation.

Organizations external to Extension can rent the simultaneous interpretation equipment for a fee of \$50.00 per day plus shipping costs. There is no charge for shipping the equipment if the organization can make alternative arrangements with OAIC staff to pick up and drop off the equipment before and after the event.

If an educator is interested in using the equipment for in-person programming, we ask for a three-week period in order to ensure its availability and to work out logistical details for shipping the equipment if necessary.
